

Arriving to the EXAM-examination in Lahti Campus, Niemenkatu 73

Please note that this is an exam situation, thus absolute silence is required. Even if your own exam has not yet started, there might be other examinees. Remember that leaving and re-entering the exam room in the middle of an exam is not allowed.

Exam room is located on Niemenkatu 73, 2nd floor, C-wing building. The code to the room is NIE73_C207. Access to the building during opening hours is through the main entrance of Niemenkatu (accessible entrance) or B2 entrance in Laatikotehtaankatu / Kampusraitti.

Access to the building/room happens with your own access tag. If you take the exam outside office hours and you do not have your own access tag, you can get temporary access tag from the info desk in the lobby of the main building from Monday to Friday at 8-16:00. You must vacate the building without delay no later than 21:30.

Please note!

Exam visit for a student from another university is possible only during weekdays between 8:00 and 16:00.

Do this:

1. Leave your coat in the hanger outside the exam room. There are lockers that can be locked inside the exam room, in which you must leave all your belongings.

- Storing your belongings at your own risk.

2. Do not take anything else to the exam computer except the locker key.

- Snacks, water bottles, drawing paper and pens are not allowed.

3. If the door to the exam room is not open, fetch the access tag from the info desk in the lobby of the main building.

4. Find the computer you have received in the exam enrollment. The number of the computer is clearly marked.

- Make sure you remember the number of the computer before you enter the exam room.

5. Put the locker key on the desk.

- Nothing else is allowed on the desk.

6. Start the exam within the exam time.

- Exams begin every hour on the dot and end five to.

- Be on time, but not too early, so as not to cause any unnecessary disturbance to others.

- The exam time starts exactly in schedule of your calendar booking.
