Mukkula M19-Campus inner yard – present state

- A meadow
- a barbeque
- A partly covered perimeter area with cobble stones
- central yard area with cobble stones sports equipment
- A hot tub for students
- Large pots for planting





Objectives & wishes

- To make the inner yard more attractive with green solutions
- To make it into a sociable, relaxing and green meeting place for the whole campus –a sort of "oasis"
- The users of the yard should be considered: students, employees and occasional visitors
- To give users new alternative ways to meet and spend time outside

Location

- The inner campus yard
- Paved area (ca. 1200–1300 m²)
- The existing structures can be used
